The resulting legal case lasted nearly a decade, alarmed church leaders of every faith, and transformed judicial thought in this highly sensitive area of American life. "Nally v. Grace Community Church of the Valley" was the nation's first case to allege "clergy malpractice," one that challenged the freedom of religious leaders to counsel their parishioners.
