




## NUTRITIONAL MANAGEMENT OF DOMESTIC ANIMALS AMIDST WATER SHORTAGES

The book creates awareness on goat milk and meat provision to increase availability of animal protein, and boost protein intake by people especially in developing countries being ravaged by protein under-nourishment. This book is a must-have for all: farmers, would-be goat keepers, researchers in the fields of Animal husbandry and Physiology, as well as the general public.
